The A.A.S. degree graduates have enhanced potential for upward progression in the career of pre-hospital care.

The curriculum includes a general education component that gives the student a well-rounded foundation of knowledge.

Current EMT-B Certification and a current BLS CPR Certification are prerequisites for this program. It is beneficial to have completed Anatomy/Physiology I and II before paramedic classes begin.
