Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic (EMT-P) is a person who works in the exciting, expanding field of Emergency Medical Services (EMS). This degree incorporates theoretical knowledge with extensive clinical application and experience. The advanced education and training in the care and transport of the critically injured can mean the difference between life and death.

Career Opportunities

Career opportunities for paramedics include: private or public ambulance companies, hospitals, community paramedic, industry and city health agencies, fire departments and law enforcement agencies. Park services, ski patrols, and other groups in many countries often educate their personnel to become EMTs or paramedics as part of their duties. This prepares students to write the National Registry Paramedic Exam.



This Diploma program allows a student to receive training and be able to enter the workforce after 3 semesters.

The credits earned in this program are transferrable to the MRC Paramedic Associate of Applied Science degree.

Helpful Background:

Current EMT-B Certification and a current BLS CPR Certification are prerequisites for this program. It is beneficial to have completed Anatomy/Physiology I and II before paramedic classes begin.
